DeCarb project

Given that the low-carbon energy shift of EU economies will have a profound economic & social impact, particularly on regions extensively involved in coal value chains, and that this transition needs to be fair, the DeCarb project aims to support public authorities in their effort to speed the clean energy transition, encourage growth and job creation, working towards a clean energy future.

More specifically by encouraging public authorities to exchange experiences in terms of a) identifying growth strategies to mitigate the impact of decarbonization b) promote public dialogue thereby resolving conflicts of interest and c) use financial support to obtain maximum benefit, DeCarb supports its participating regions to secure sustainable development and economic stability in a time of change.

DeCarb Activity A1

Under A1 Activity, partners will document the socioeconomic impact of COVID-19 on DeCarb regions (e.g., new layoffs, drop in energy demand, drawbacks in diversification), to identify common policy gaps and recovery & resilience pathways (incl. digital & green growth approaches, risk management & energy citizenship for resilient transitions).

For this purpose, the activity led by SZREDA, is to develop a methodology with data collection tools and input forms that will enable partners to survey the socio-economic impacts of COVID-19 in DeCarb regions (incorporating elements of a SWOT analysis and to identify resilience and recovery policy opportunities for fortifying decarbonisation transitions in DeCarb regions from future crises with emphasis on best practices exchanges)

Description of Services to be provided

More specifically the study developed by INNOVELA will:

- a) Consolidate the data collected by partners according to the methodology of the A1 activity.
- b) Present and analyse policy implementation challenges regarding decarbonisation transitions in DeCarb regions.
- c) Share potential pathways as regards recovery and resilience policy opportunities for fortifying decarbonisation transitions in DeCarb regions, based on the best approaches identified by partners.
- d) Summarise the lessons learnt from the analysis, identifying the socio-economic impact of the COVID-19 crisis on the decarbonisation transitions in partnership regions.
