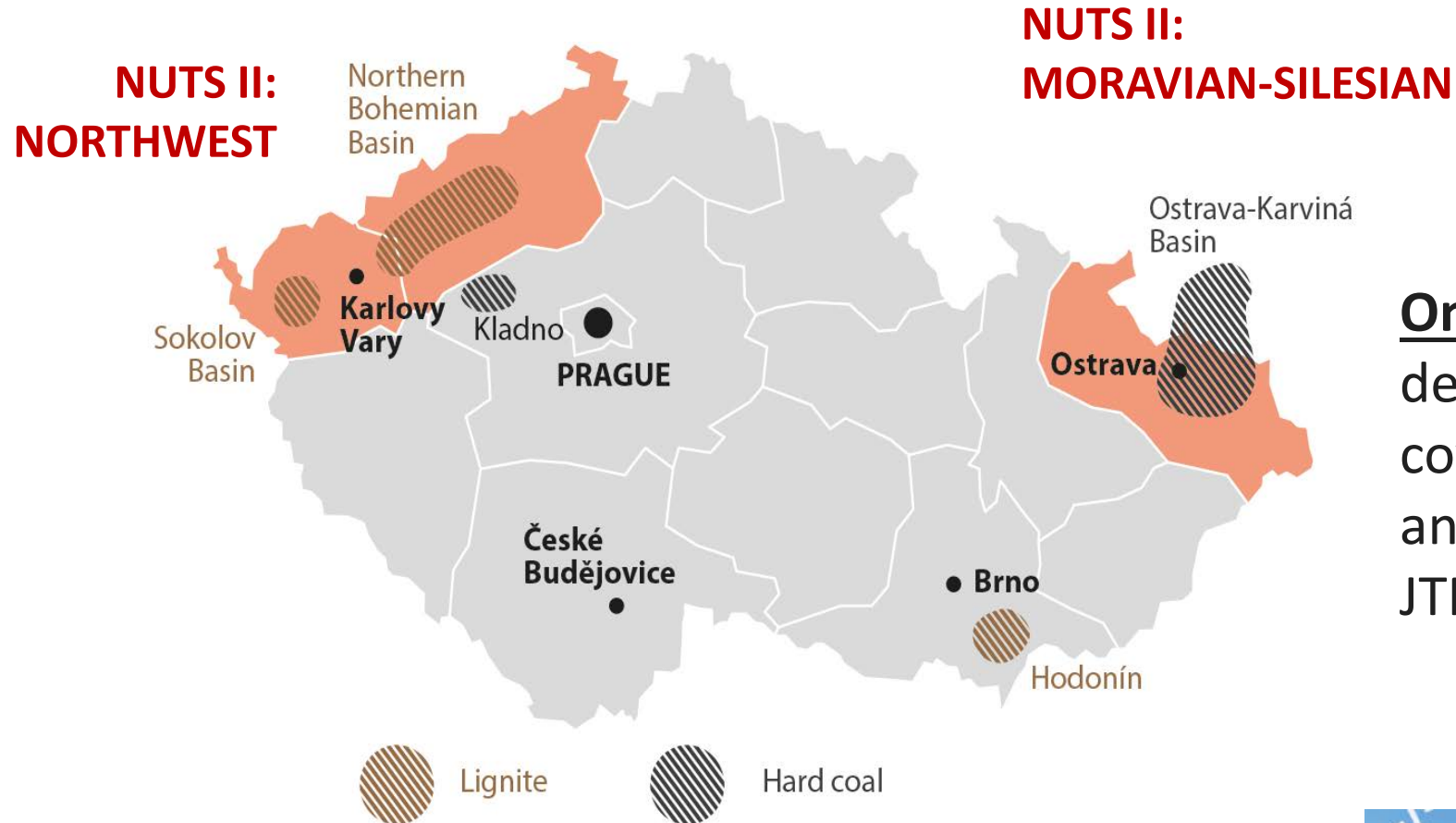

Karlovy Vary and Usti region in the northwest and Moravia-Silesia region in the northeast part of the country.



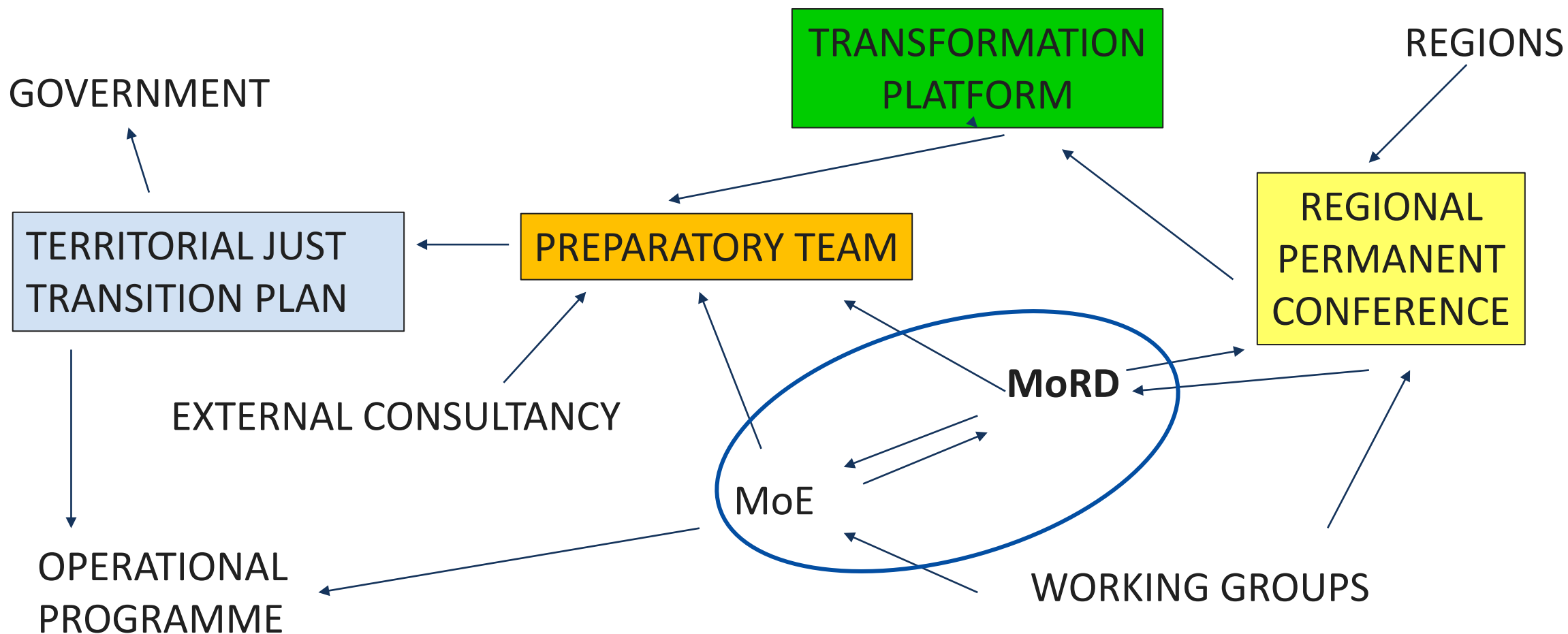
**One TJTP with specific parts dedicated to each coal region covering their needs, challenges and priorities... for support from JTM.**



# Overview on Just Transition Mechanism in CZ

- **Operational Programme Just Transition** – Ministry of Environment (MoE)
- **Territorial Just Transition Plan** – Ministry of Regional Development (MoRD)
- **RE:START department** (MoRD) is assigned to elaboration of **TJTP**
  
- **Coordination with regional partners** is built on existing and parallel **structure of RE:START strategy** that was completed with new features such as Transformation platform.
- „**Top down**“ and „**bottom up**“ approach - use of **umbrella organizations**
- Communication with other partners – **websites** (MoE, MoRD, regional governments), **regional cooperation, workshops**, consultations and interviews carried out by external consultancy

# Structure and process of preparation of TJTP



# Timeline

- First round of **working groups** under MoE – September 2020
- 5/10/2020 – start of **consultancy services** (5 tasks, 9 month)
- 6/10/2020 – first meeting of **Transformation platform**
- 15/10/2020 - first draft of TJTP presented to CZ government
- 2/10/2020 – first meeting of **preparatory team** ( x executive team within MoRD)
- December 2020 – second rounds of meetings
- **February 2021** - Regional **workshops on JTM** (business and public sector)
- Finalization of TJTP - **1. Q 2021** -> SEA process -> approval of CZ government  
-> European Commission



# Challenges and issues to deal with

- **Lack of clarity in EU regulation** (still persisting within II. and III. pillar of JTM) and **legislation delay**
- **Cooperation with many stakeholders** and their **involvement** into the process of preparation TJTP
- **Time pressure** (time-consuming process of approval, connection to Partnership Agreement...)
- **Particular issues** that require further specification (involvement of state enterprises, large companies, conception of sustainable tourism etc.)
- **Division of allocation between regions** and **criteria** for selection of right projects for funding
